ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA FOR EXAMINATIONS

e-Governance Cell Instructions for e-Attendance

The Board Examination will be conducted by the Directorate of Technical Education, Chennai at the end of each year/Semester, both in theory and practical subjects. The candidate will be permitted to appear for the Board Examinations provided,

- 1) As only 75 % attendance is considered as the eligibility criteria, students may be encouraged to utilize the remaining 20% for participation in NSS/NCC/Sports/Seminars/Extra Curricular activities.
- 2) Students participation in NSS/Sports/NCC/Seminar may be given as OD (on duty) after the certificate of attendance from the concerned staff in charge and it should be added with the regular attendance in the respective month (refer e-form-03). OD hours should be marked as "OD" in the attendance register.
- 3) Students taking medical leave should be marked as "ML" in the attendance maintained in the Institutions and in the remarks column the staff incharge should clearly write the student has submitted the medical certificate for that period (refer e-form-01).
- 4) If a student has shortage of attendance in particular month the same should be informed to the Parent/Guardian/Ward by the Principal of the Polytechnic College (refer e-form-02).
- 5) Parent/Student can login and view the attendance status as on date by entering the Student Register number.
- 6) e-form-01 Medical certificate submission. e-form-02-Letter intimation to the Parents (both in English and Tamil). e-form-03 - On duty submission.
- 7) The number of hours allotted for a student in extra curricular activities may be limited by the Institute considering academic performance. Students in person will not be entertained in DOTE for sanctioning medical leave, OD etc., especially at the time of issue of hall tickets.

- 8) Extra classes conducted in the Polytechnic College will not be accounted for the percentage of attendance calculation.

TIME LIMIT FOR THE COMPLETION OF THE DIPLOMA COURSES

- i) Regular Students admitted in 1 year / 6 years since 1st admission
- ii) HSC Vocational/Academic Students admitted / 5 years since 1st admission

Criteria for Pass

- 1. No candidates shall be eligible for the award of Diploma unless he/she has undergone the prescribed course of study successfully in an Institution approved by AICTE and affiliated to the State Board of Technical Education & Trading, Tamil Nadu and pass all the subjects prescribed in the curriculum
- 2. A candidate shall be declared to have passed the examination in a subject if he/she secures not less than 40% in theory and 50% in practical subject out of the total prescribed maximum marks including both the session and the Board Examination marks put together, subject to the condition that he/she secures at least a minimum of 40 marks out of 100 marks in the Board's Theory and a minimum of 50 marks out of 100 marks in the Board Practical Examinations

Classification of successful candidates

Classification of candidates who will pass out the final examination from April 2018 onwards (Joined in first year in 2015-2016) will be done as specified below.

First Class with Superlative Distinction :

A candidate will be declared to have passed in First Class with Superlative Distinction if he/she secures not less than 75% of the marks in all the subjects and passes all the semesters in the first appearance itself and passes all subjects within the stipulated period of study 3 / 3 ½ / 4 years (Full Time / Sandwich / Part Time) without any break in study.

First Class with Distinction :

A candidate will be declared to have passed in First Class with Distinction if he/she secures not less than 75% of the aggregate marks in all the semesters put together and passes all the semesters except the I and II semester in the first appearance itself and passes all subjects within the stipulated period of study 3 / 3 ½ / 4 years (Full Time / Sandwich / Part Time) without any break in study.

First Class:

A candidate will be declared to have passed in First class if he / she secures not less than 60% of the aggregate marks in all semesters put together, except that of first year and completes all papers including that of first year within the stipulated period of studying 3 / 3 ½ / 4 years without any break.

Second Class :

All other successful candidates will be declared to have passed in Second Class.

RULES OF CONDUCT AND DISCIPLINE

1. The conduct and character of each student should be good.
2. Students should adopt dress code as instructed from time to time.
3. They should be punctual to classes and attend to their work with devotion.
4. A student shall not leave the classroom at his/her will or enter the class session as he/she pleases.
5. Damage of any kind, done to the Institution's property will be viewed seriously. The cost of the same shall be recovered from the erring student. Students should help to maintain the Institution's property as their own.
6. This refers to the maintenance of Institution's buildings, walls of rooms, furniture and books available in the library.
7. Tampering with electrical fittings is not only dangerous but also attracts suitable penal action.
8. The students should acquaint themselves with the Notifications put up on the Notice Board.
9. Malpractice and misbehaviour will be viewed seriously and might lead to termination under extreme Circumstances.
10. No meeting shall be organized without getting prior written permission from the Principal.
11. Day-Scholars are not allowed to enter the hostel without the permission of the Warden / Deputy Warden.

Breach of any of the above rules will lead to take disciplinary action resulting in suspension or expulsion.

PROHIBITION OF RAGGING TAMILNADU GOVERNMENT GAZETTE EXTRAORDINARY

The Following Act of the Tamil Nadu Legislative Assembly received the assent of the Governor on 14th February 1997 and is hereby published for general information.

ACT NO. 7 OF 1997

An Act to prohibit ragging in Educational institutions in the State of Tamil Nadu.

Be it enacted by the Legislative Assembly of the State of Tamil Nadu in the forty eighth year of Republic of India as follows.

Short title, extent and commencement

1. i) This Act may be called the Tamil Nadu Prohibitory of Ragging Act 1997.
- ii) It extends to the whole of the State of Tamil Nadu.
- iii) It shall be deemed to have come into force on the 19th day of December 1996.

Definition

2. In this Act unless the context otherwise requires, "ragging" means display of noisy, disorderly conduct doing any act which causes or is likely to cause physical or psychological harm or raise apprehension or fear or shame or embarrassment to a student in any Educational Institution and includes
 - i) teasing, abusing of playing practical jokes on, or causing hurt to such student; or
 - ii) asking the student to do any act or perform something which such student will not in the ordinary course willingly do.

PROHIBITION OF RAGGING

3. Ragging within or out side of Educational campus is prohibited.

PENALTY FOR RAGGING

4. Whoever directly or indirectly commits, participates in, abets or propagates "ragging" within or outside the Educational campus, shall be punished with imprisonment for a term which may extend to two years and shall also be liable to a fine which may extend to Rs. 10,000/-.

DISMISSAL OF STUDENT

5. Any student convicted of offence under section 4 shall also be dismissed from the Educational Institution and such student shall not be admitted in any other Educational Institution.

SUSPENSION OF STUDENT

6. i) Without prejudice to the foregoing provisions whenever any student complains of ragging to the Head of an Educational Institution, or to any other person responsible for management of the Educational Institution, such head of Educational Institution person responsible for the management of the Educational Institution shall inquire into the same immediately and if found true shall suspend the student, who has committed the offence, from the Educational Institution.
- ii) The decision of the Head of the Educational Institution or the person responsible for the management of the Educational Institution that any student has indulged in ragging under subsection (1) shall be final.

DEEMED ABETMENT

7. If the Head of the Educational Institution or the person responsible for the management of the Educational Institution fails or neglects to take action in the manner specified in sub section (1) of section 6 when a complaint of ragging is made, such person shall be deemed to have abetted the offence of ragging and shall be punished as provided for in Section 4.

POWER TO MAKE RULES

8. i) The State Government may make rules for carrying out all or any of the purposes of this Act.
- ii) All rules made under this Act shall be published in the Tamilnadu Government Gazette and unless, they are expressed to come into force on particular day, shall come into force on the day on which they are so published.
- iii) Every rule made under this Act shall, as soon as possible after its made, be placed on the table so the Legislative Assembly and if, before the expiry of the session in which it is so placed or the next session, the Assembly makes any modification in any such rule, or the Assembly decides that the rule should not be made, the rule shall thereafter have effect only in such modified form or be of no effect, as the case may, be so however, that any such modification or annulment shall be without prejudice to the validity of anything previously done under that rule.

REPEAL AND SAVING - TAMIL NADU ORDINANCE 10 OF 1996

9. i) The Tamil Nadu Prohibition of Ragging Ordinance 1996 is hereby replaced.
- ii) Notwithstanding such repeal, anything done or any action taken under the ordinance shall be deemed to have been done or taken under this Act. (By Order of the Governor) Secretary to Government, Law Department

ATTENDANCE AND LEAVE

1. Students should attend classes regularly.
2. However, leave of absence will have to be obtained from the Principal in advance for valid reasons. In case of sickness, a medical certificate should accompany the leave application.
3. Attendance shall be calculated on hour basis i.e. in terms of each lecture hour.
4. The student is liable to be paid penalty if he/she absents himself/herself without permission.
5. Attendance at the Examinations and Tests are compulsory.

SCHOLARSHIP

Applications are encouraged to seek the State Government's scholarships by all eligible Backward Classes and SC/ST candidates.

NOTE : Failure to put in 90% attendance by the recipient of the scholarships will lead to forfeiture of the same.

IDENTITY CARD TO STAFF AND STUDENTS

Staff members and students are given identity cards. They are instructed to carry their identity card with them always and shall produce their identity card on demand at any time while they are on-campus.

The Library block has been donated to the college by family members of late Thiru. C. DORAISAMY, Founder Correspondent. It has been named after this visionary as "CD MEMORIAL LIBRARY ". The library consists of a large number of text and reference books in different disciplines.. The library subscribes to National and International Hardy Online Journals.

The library has subscribed online subscription Database at the cost of Rs.22 Lakhs under AICTE agreement based subscription. The library is systematically arranged with Indian and Foreign books, National and International magazines. It is functioning under a computerized system. Library has DELNET SERVICE from LIBRARY NETWORK and has established DIGITAL LIBRARY SERVICE. Other than this service we are the members of British Council Library, Chennai and American Information Resource Center Chennai, CIPET Chennai for inter library loan services.

KPC Library

There is a special library for our Kongu Polytechnic College Students. The library consists of a number of text books and reference books in different disciplines. It has a total number of 4807 volumes in 2087 titles. It also consists of 23 journals, magazines and 822 project reports and 646 Eos.

LIBRARY RULES

1. All the students are entitled to borrow two books at any instant from the library. However, Reference Books and Journals will not be lent out. Books will be issued up to 4.00 P.M. on all working days.
2. Every student is entitled to keep any borrowed book for a fortnight from the date of issue.
3. Every book borrowed from the library should be returned on the return date marked on the Date-Slip. It may be re-issued to the same person for a further period of two weeks, only if there is no call on the same book.
4. If the librarian recalls any book, at any time even before the expiry of the normal period of loan, the book should be returned.
5. If a student fails to return a book on the due date, a fine of Re. 1 per day will be levied

6. Absence from college will not be admitted as an excuse for delay in the return of books.
7. Students are requested to use all library books with care. Marking, underlining or annotating in the books is forbidden. Disciplinary action will be taken against students damaging books in any manner.
8. All payments including fines regarding the library should be paid in college office and receipts should be produced to the librarian.
9. Perfect silence and decorum should be maintained in the library. The librarian may recover the library cards from those who violate rules.
10. A student who loses his/her library card should at once report the matter to the librarian. Duplicate library cards will be issued on payment of penalty Rs. 25/- per card.
11. In case, the borrowed book is lost, double the cost of the latest price of book will be collected from the defaulter with other charges, if any.

The centre is well endowed with high-end graphics workstations and structured cabling with a server running on Windows 2003 and connecting 72 systems. The centre offers access to software like AutoCAD 2006, Pro/ENGINEER, Wildfire 4.0, EdgeCAM 10, UNIGRAPHICS NX 4.0, Pro/MECHANICA, I-DEAS, Master CAM V10, CATIA V5 ED2 and Mechanical Desktop 2006 etc.,

LATHE SECTION

Recently purchased 20 Production machines with high accurate quality and total value of approximately Rs 40 Lakhs. It is a platform for Mechanical, Automobile & Mechatronics students for machining processes.

MACHINE SHOP

The High quality of various types of special production Machineries are purchased for the total value of Rs 50 Lakhs. This all kind of machines are pillars of Mech, Auto & MTS students and update the practical knowledge of machining operations.

WORK SHOP

Workshop is made compulsory for all the students to improve their technical skills. Hence, a well equipped new workshop has been established at a cost of Rs. 5.25 Lakhs. The workshop is endowed with Fitting, Carpentry, Sheet Metal & Wiring Sections. It enables the students to develop their basic knowledge about engineering field.

ENGLISH COMMUNICATION LAB

A well-equipped English Communication laboratory has been established at a cost of Rs. 6 Lakhs. Modern facilities such as Television, video cassettes recorder. Tape recorder along with Public address system are used to train the students with audio players.

AUTOMOBILE LAB

Automobile lab has been constructed at a sq feet of 7728 with modern engines, computerized Diesel Engine Test Rig with Eddy Current Dynamometer and FIP calibration bench. A well equipped Pneumatic & Hydraulics Lab trainer kit costs for Rs.4,50,000.00. Additionally Pneumatic simulation software. This lab will be more helpful for the students to thrive well in Automation industry.

ELECTRONICS LAB

Electronics laboratory is used to perform the experiments on basic electronics, circuits, measurements and industrial electronics. This lab is equipped with power supplies, CRO's, Function Generators, and Measuring Instruments with all electronics devices, components & kits.

ELECTRONICS & DIGITAL LAB

Electronics & Digital Lab is developed for worth Rs. 20 Lakhs. Lab is equipped with power supplies, CRO's, Function Generators and Measuring Instruments. Here experiments related with basic electronics, Basic Electronics, Digital Electronics, Circuits, Measurements, Power Electronics, Industrial Electronics Engineering are performed.

COMMUNICATION LAB

The experiments related with communication, Optical Communication, Transmitters and Receivers are performed in this communication

laboratory. This lab is equipped with Radio receiver Kits, T.V. demonstration Kits, Digital Receivers, fiber optical kits and Antenna Models.

MICROPROCESSOR LAB

The Microprocessor lab is established to study about the programming and interfacing peripherals with the microprocessor. This lab is equipped with 8085, 8086 based Microprocessor Kits. Same lab is equipped with 8051 Micro controller Kits which is used to study the Embedded system.

HARDWARE SERVICING LAB

Computer installation and servicing of hardware, peripherals are done here. This lab consists of 64 Computer system and various peripherals. The lab is equipped with simulation softwares such as LabView, PSpice, MP Lab, ORCAD and MODELSIM. Students can perform in C, C++, Electrical CAD, Auto CAD etc., Same computer centre is used to perform experiments on VLSI design, Virtual Instrumentation & Embedded System.
